

INSTALLING A HUSBAND?

Dear Tech Support,

Last year I upgraded from Boyfriend 5.0 to Husband 1.0 and noticed a distinct slow down in overall system performance, particularly in the flower and jewelry applications, which operated flawlessly under Boyfriend 5.0.

In addition, Husband 1.0 uninstalled many other valuable programs, such as Romance 9.5 and Personal Attention 6.5 and then installed undesirable programs such as NBA 5.0, NFL 3.0 and Golf Clubs 4.1. Conversation 8.0 no longer runs, and Housecleaning 2.6 simply crashes the system.

I've tried running Nagging 5.3 to fix these problems, but to no avail. What can I do?

DEAR DESPERATE,

First keep in mind, Boyfriend 5.0 is an Entertainment Package, while Husband 1.0 is an operating system. Please enter command: `ithoughtyoulovedme.html` and try to download Tears 6.2 and don't forget to install the Guilt 3.0 update. If that application works as designed, Husband 1.0 should then automatically run the applications Jewelry 2.0 and Flowers 3.5.

But remember, overuse of the above application can cause Husband 1.0 to default to Grumpy Silence 2.5, Happy Hour 7.0 or Beer 6.1. Please note that Beer 6.1 is a very bad program that will download the Snoring Loudly Beta. Whatever you do, DO NOT install Mother-In-Law 1.0 (it runs a virus in the background that will eventually seize control of all your system resources.) Also do not attempt to reinstall Boyfriend 5.0 program. These are unsupported applications and will crash Husband 1.0.

Pastor's Commentary And Outline

(HIGH Places)

We have an altar, whereof they have no right to eat which serve the tabernacle.
Heb 13:10

Neither do they desire it. This altar is Christ crucified, and only hungry sinners, in need of a Sovereign will find satisfaction in Christ alone. This is for the priesthood of new testament believers, who see Christ as the end of the law for righteousness, to all believing. They eat of his sacrifice, and are satisfied.

But high place? These are the substitute altars, which littered the landscape of Israel. Everywhere were they to be found. In valleys, mountains, hills, and under every green tree. They were pagan shrines, baals. And God ultimately had to destroy Israel for choosing this delusion over HIM! *For of old time I have broken thy yoke, and burst thy bands; and thou saidst, I will not transgress; when upon every high hill and under every green tree thou wanderest, playing the harlot.* Jer 2:20

That thou hast also built unto thee an eminent place, and hast made thee an high place in every street.

25 Thou hast built thy high place at every head of the way, and hast made thy beauty to be abhorred, and hast opened thy feet to every one that passed by, and multiplied thy whoredoms. Ezek 16:24

Here God uses the language of an offended husband, who sees His wife given to promiscuity and infidelity.

Idolatry is highly offensive to the true and living God. Israel was told to destroy all false altars. Deut 7:5,6

This would insure God's favor, and the evidence of their love for him, alone. Ex 20:1-3

Eventually they left God, and were overcome by the groves, altars, shrines, and high places of the heathen. They were beautiful to the eyes. The scent of their incense was alluring. These gods, all of them, promised prosperity of land, homes, and domestic affairs, but, you had to work for it. You had to service these false gods. **Here are seven high places which have distracted professing Christians and have detracted from God's glory in Christ, in this generation which you live.**

Music (secular oriented), dancing, tithing, tongues, pagan mystical prayers, decisional regeneration, freewill works religion. These have all become high places, (objects of worship) which have entered into Christendom, by which men have lost sight of the true and living God, and the gospel of His glory in Christ. Anywhere that these are featured, Christ is absent!
